

Open Data Licence

You are encouraged to use and re-use the Information that is available under this Licence freely and flexibly, with only a few conditions.

1. Using the Information under this Northern Powergrid Open Data Licence

- 1.1 Northern Powergrid is the Licensor and the Information Provider for the purpose of this Licence.
- 1.2 The conditions of this Licence are important and if you fail to comply with them the rights granted to you under this Licence, or any similar licence granted by the Licensor, will end automatically.

2. Using Information under this Licence
