Date	What's happening
14 June 2018	<p>We are now three weeks into our £1.75 million investment works in Skelton.</p> <p>This programme of works is designed to improve the resilience of the local electricity supply both now and in the future by replacing existing underground cables and upgrading a number of substations with new equipment.</p> <p>We've now completed our planned high voltage cable laying works in North Skelton. As part of these works we've installed a temporary substation at North Skelton West and there will be a short planned power interruption this week while this work is completed. This will affect five properties and we have directly contacted those customers so they understand what is happening and why.</p> <p>We're now starting our planned works in New Skelton. We've started to lay cables along the Low Stanghow Road towards Skelton Rievaulx substation on Rievaulx Road and anticipate this work will be completed by the end of this month.</p> <p>Next we will be working in and around Byland Road and Jervaulx Road before heading down Low Stanghow Road towards Marlborough Road. Firm timings of these works will be confirmed shortly.</p> <p>Our programme is running to schedule and we'll continue to communicate by letter with all customers who will be directly affected by these works.</p>
