

Investing £7.5 million in Doncaster

Investing in your community

At Northern Powergrid our teams work 24/7 to manage the network that powers everyday life for 8 million customers across 3.9 million homes and businesses in the North East, Yorkshire and northern Lincolnshire.

We understand the important role a safe, reliable power supply has in supporting communities and that's why we're investing £7.5 million to upgrade our assets and improve the resilience of our network in and around Armthorpe, Bessacarr, Branton, Cantley and Rossington.

Our work in your area is taking place between the end of June 2022 and summer 2023. It will focus on replacing an 8.3km overhead power line and more than 60 supports with a combination of new underground cables and a small section of modern new overhead line. This will significantly improve the appearance of the local landscape.

Supported by upgrades at local substations, the new equipment will be capable of meeting any future increase in demand for power as the area develops, the population grows and people become more reliant on electricity to power their businesses, heat their homes and charge electric vehicles.

From the end of June 2022 until the end of March 2023, we'll be excavating in the roadway, footpath and grass verges to install a total of 10.6km of new underground cables. Then from April 2023 until summer 2023, we'll be removing the old overhead network.

The work is being carried out on our behalf by our contractor, Balfour Beatty and, inside, you'll find a map providing more information about where they'll be working.



Working closely with Doncaster Council and local landowners, we're doing all we can to ensure this scheme causes as little disruption as possible by using multiple teams and avoiding any noisy activities if we work at the weekend for example.

We're committed to keeping local people informed and will write to all those directly affected by the work as well as sharing information through your local councillors, the media and social media.

We're not planning to turn off anyone's power during this work and it's unlikely we'll need access to homes or businesses. We'll maintain pedestrian access to premises and make sure that businesses continue to receive their deliveries.

We'll be sharing more information about our £7.5 million investment in the months ahead, including details of any traffic management measures we'll need to put in place. In the meantime, thank you for your patience while we carry out this important investment work to improve your local power network.

We're replacing sections of our overhead network with more modern and sustainable underground and overhead technology. From the end of June 2022 until the end of March 2023, this will involve us digging in the road, footpath or grass verge along the route shown in red and this may cause disruption to local businesses, residents and road users.

From April 2023 until summer 2023, we'll be removing the old overhead poles and lines.

We're committed to carrying out the work as safely and promptly as possible while minimising disruption. We'll be keeping those directly affected informed. NB. Routes and dates of work may be subject to change.


